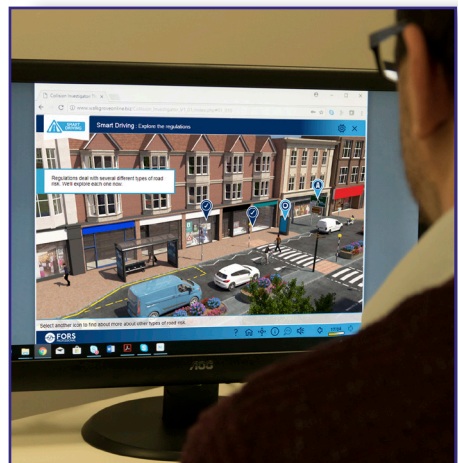
FORS Professional is a comprehensive package of essential training for managers and drivers, delivered with cutting edge content to help operators meet the FORS Standard.

As part of the FORS Professional suite of training, there are a number of eLearning modules available for both managers and drivers.







The FORS eLearning modules are immersive, online experiences that provide challenging scenarios, in a controlled way.

FORS eLearning modules generally take 30-40 minutes to complete and are followed by a short quiz. Certificates are available to download on successful completion of the quiz and the participant's name will automatically be added to the FORS Professional training register.








eLearning for drivers

-  **Van Smart** – by simulating a typical driver's day, this module highlights good practice that all van drivers should be using.
-  **Cycle Safety** – enables drivers to recognise the causes of accidents and how to minimise the risks to vulnerable road users.
-  **Smart Driving** – focuses on the basics of road safety and explores some of the more advanced techniques of concentration, observation and anticipation.
-  **Smart Deliveries** – aims to encourage drivers to comply more closely with the rules and regulations associated with parking and loading, thus avoiding fines and charges.
-  **LoCITY: Time to clean up** – course participants will learn fuel efficient driving techniques to save fuel and benefit the environment.
-  **TruckSmart** – focuses on the importance of driving roadworthy HGVs and the role of the driver in ensuring that vehicles and loads are safe and legal at all times.

eLearning for managers

-  **LoCITY: Time to look ahead** – managers will benefit from a thorough grounding in alternative fuel vehicles and their pros and cons against traditional diesel and petrol power.
-  **Road Risk Champion** – for those who have attended the classroom learning.
-  **Collision Investigator** – for those who will be investigating collisions and who have attended the classroom learning.

Limited online access?

To support those operators and drivers with limited computer access, PowerPoint group delivery training packs are available for a number of eLearning modules. The aim of the training pack is to provide an alternative method of delivering the messages covered in the eLearning modules.
